Asansol-Burnpur-Raniganj-Durgapur is popular for its unique industrial culture and heritage. The region is surrounded by coal mines, steel plants and variety of large and small scale industries which give the place a distinguished demography and character.

The city is well connected with railways and roadways. There are multiple trains and bus services that run regularly (on daily basis) connecting Kolkata, Jharkhand, Bihar and Delhi. Asansol, the second largest city of West Bengal, is about 200 kms from Kolkata. Asansol is close to Patna, Ranchi, Bodhgaya, Varanasi. The railway station and bus terminus are only around 1.5 kms of the main city and close to Bijoy Pal Memorial B.Ed College. In the newly inaugurated airport at Andal i.e. Kazi Nazrul Islam Airport (35km), connecting flights are

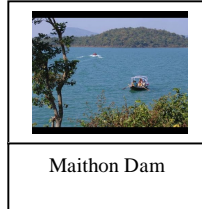
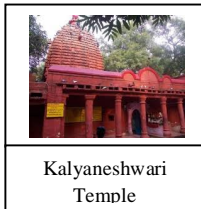
